About HUMBUG

The Technical Operator will be responsible for the smooth running of both Lighting and Sound during all performances of HUMBUG. This hands-on role requires confidence in operating a fully cued show environment integrating live music, click tracks, and timecoded lighting.

The Role

We're looking for a super organised and proactive Production Coordinator to join our team on a freelance basis. You'll be working across a busy mix of live projects, supporting our Producers and Production Managers to keep everything running smoothly.

Key Responsibilities

- Operate Lighting and Sound and FX during all performances, ensuring all cues are executed accurately.
- Work with timecoded lighting sequences synchronised to click tracks.
- Mix live band audio and wireless head mics for cast and performers.
- Monitor and manage in-ear systems for both band and cast.
- Troubleshoot or swap out fixtures, microphones, and equipment if issues arise.
- Attend technical rehearsals, sitzprobe, and other rehearsals as required by the Producer or Production Manager.
- Cue the show independently, maintaining consistency between performances.
- Collaborate closely with the Production Manager and creative team to implement cues and show adjustments.
- Assist during load-in, setup, and strike as required.
- Undertake any other reasonable duties expected of a Technical Operator on an immersive production.

Experience & Skills

- At least 1 year of professional experience working in live theatre or immersive environments.
- Experience mixing live bands and managing wireless microphone systems.
- Proficiency operating lighting and sound systems with timecoded show playback.
- Understanding of in-ear monitoring and click track integration.

- Strong troubleshooting and multitasking ability under pressure.
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills.
- A proactive, self-sufficient approach to cueing and technical maintenance.
